



## **About The Cover**

This issue's cover is a close up of John Martin's The Plains of Heaven. which is the middle panel of his famous apocalyptic-themed triptych (3 panel painting) called "Judgement Days." The three panels from left to right were The Last Judgement, The Plains of Heaven, and The Great Day of His Wrath. He worked on the triptych late in his life, from 1851-1853.

John Martin was an English romantic painter and engraver who lived from 1789-1854. Though he often painted biblical subjects, the moody, dreamlike atmosphere of his paintings sets his work apart from traditional religious art. Though he received mixed reviews from the critics and art establishment, the public revered him, and his art showings were hugely popular.

Martin's Brother Jonathan, who suffered from mental illness, once set fire to the York Minster Hotel in York, England. A local reporter said that the eerie, fiery scene reminded him of a John Martin painting, without knowing that the arsonist was in fact the brother of the painter!
