#### Some Punk Rock Tidbits

- The term "Punk" was derived from old prison slang, where a Punk would be the equivalent to a modern day male prison "Bitch". Yeah, you get the idea.
- Punk also refers to something that is inferior, or of poor quality. Punk Rock, as an aesthetic, is based on energy and zeal, not necessarily on great musicianship or production. As a result, it is often criticized as being primitive and even stupid. So in the eyes of the critic, Punk Rock is truly "punk".
- In the late '70s and early '80s, the band "X" broke away from the "garage band" stereotype of Punk. X actually used great musicianship and production values, while still holding to the core values of punk rock. Influences of Rockabilly, Country, Rock, and Jazz could be heard in their songs. Producer Ray Manzarek (former Door's keyboardist) brought his creativity and years of experience to help mold a polished sound for the band.
- Many of the early Punk Rockers were heavily influenced by Surf Music. It's a connection
  that still holds strong to this day. Surf Music, as a unique genre, has changed very little
  since its heyday in the mid '60s. However, it has greatly evolved as an important stylistic
  element within Punk.
